Kobe Bryant was charged with third degree sexual assault on July 18, 2003, for an incident occurring at Cordillera with a 19-year-old Eagle woman on June 30, 2003. The impact of the trial, held at the Eagle County Courthouse, was profound for Eagle, Colorado.
