

Eagle County, Colorado - Newcomer Ranch Cemetery

This cemetery is located on what is now the Headquarters of the Adams Rib Ranch about 4 miles up Brush Creek Rd., south of the town of Eagle.

- **FROST**, W. E. d. Nov 19, 1920

"The east one is a marble stone about 32 inches high and 24 inches wide and five inches thick on a white marble base six inches wider than the main stone. The stone of Mrs. Love is back in a dense thicket of wild rose bushes and has had a woven wire fence with an iron gate around it. All is mashed down now."

- **GARVEY**, Denis d. May 17, 1888 Age 64
- **LOVE**, Ellen S., Wife of J. W. LOVE d. May 14, 1898 Age 58

"The other headstone is also in white marbel. It has a 12 inch square base with names and dates on three sides. The upper part is round and tapered. One side has:

- **MASON**, Nellie - daughter of H. J. & C. MASON d. Oct 2, 1890 Age 1 Mo., 12 days
- **MATTHEWS**, Andrew - Son of Robert and G. MATTHEWS d. April 4, 1893 Age 5 Months, 4 days

"The other graves are out in the open and are marked with small foot stones with their initials on them, all within a few feet of the one headstone."

- **SMITH**, Azariah b. Abt. Sep, 1837 - d. Dec 12, 1919
